Christian Seidl has submitted that he will not seek re-election in this year's Assembly; his resignation will be effective on the 14.05.2008

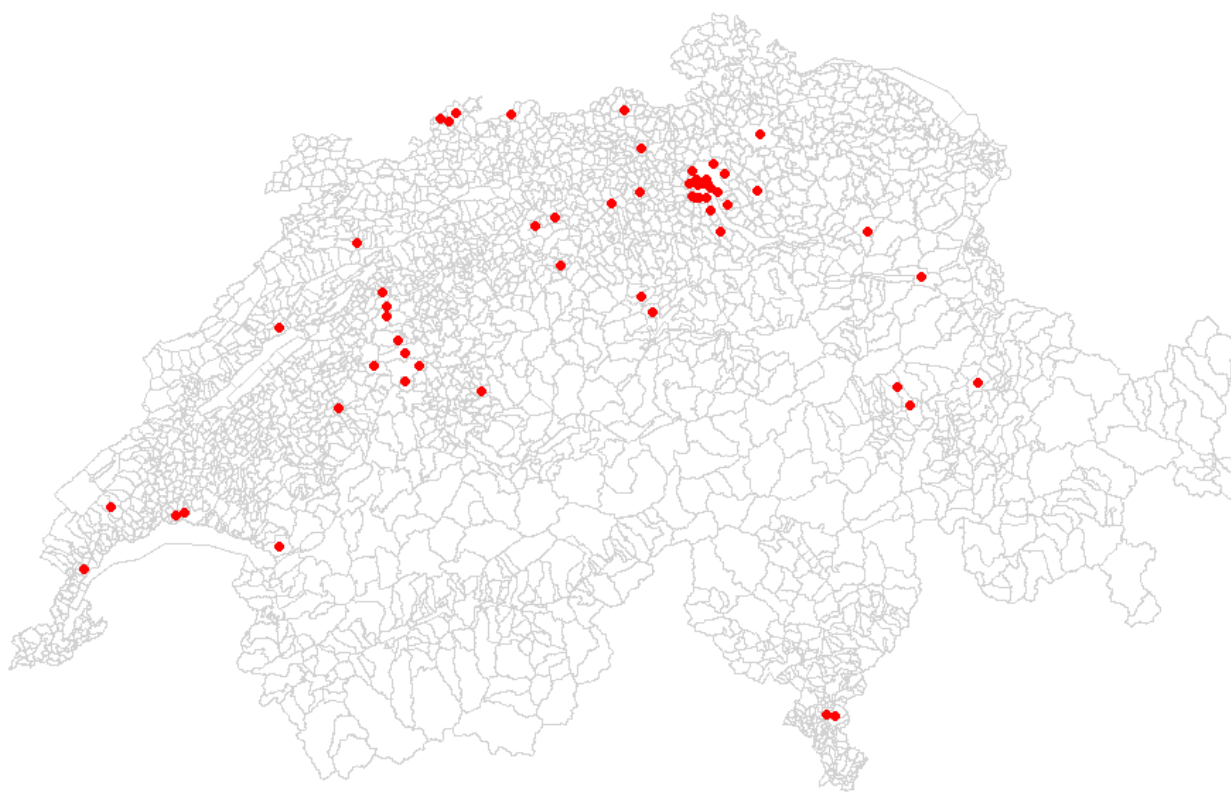

Wikipedia Day Berne

On September 29, 2007 the third Swiss Wikipedia Day took place at the College of Education in Berne (PHBern). It was mainly sponsored by the PHBern. Further sponsor were Migros-Kulturprozent and Digitale Allmend. The content of the Wikipedia Day aimed at 'science workers' such as teachers, lecturers, students and journalists. The introductory speech was held by Nadine Masshardt, youngest member of the parliament of the Canton of Berne.

A workshop about Wikipedia was held by Christian Seidl, Administrator in the German Wikipedia and board member of Wikimedia CH. The Wikipedia day was moderated by Wolf Ludwig, co-president of Comunica-ch.

More than 60 visitors were counted at the time of the first speech. By guess, another 20 visitors came later. Our member Manuel Schneider transmitted the speeches live in the internet; about 80 additional persons used this service. Media were very interested in the Wikipedia Day in Berne. It was mentioned in multiple broadcasts of Swiss Radio DRS and in several newspapers. The Tagesschau of Swiss TV (SF) was present with a team and brought a substantial report in the main edition on the same evening. (See also Press Review, below)

Wikipedia Day Lugano

The second Wikipedia Day had been scheduled for the 4th and 5th May 2007 in the SUPSI (Scuola Universitaria Professionale della Svizzera Italiana), in Manno, near Lugano. It was organized by Wikimedia CH with the collaboration of Wikimedia Italia and SUPSI.

The subject of the 2nd Wikipedia Day was: “Open Software, Open Content and its main aim was to explain and make clear the difference between these two concepts.

So far, software was the thing one would think of when hearing the term "open content", but with Wikipedia a new chapter began, applying concepts like the GFDL to texts, images, videos, and so forth.

The first day introduced free software and the licenses which go along with it, the second day explained what Wikipedia is, and what Wikimedia is.

Workshops during the Wikipedia Day included ‘Making articles’, ‘Wikification and format’, ‘Patrolling’, ‘Related projects’, ‘Equipments to write’ and ‘Equipments to control’.

Further activities

CD2

Wikimedia CH is taking part in a project called “Collaborative Distributed – Content Development“, which is led by the Libresoft Group at the Universidad Rey Juan Carlos in Madrid. Quoting from the project description:

“The main goal of the CD2 project is to develop a new technical infrastructure to support the deployment of large coordinated collections of multimedia materials. The architectural design of this infrastructure will be based on the premises of exploiting opportunities for decentralisation (including large scale usage of donated resources hosted at user locations), collaborative enhancements to the collection (including collaborative editing) and production and improvement of materials by consumers of information (prosumers). The project will use extensively Wikipedia and other Mediawiki projects as case examples, for gaining knowledge about their social usage, and for establishing test beds dealing with real problems. The infrastructure will be based upon emerging technologies (wikis, peer to peer networking and the Web 2.0) for improving data accessibility and system availability. The project will also analyse and present convenient strategies for the exploitation of the new solutions developed inside this research initiative. All of this is expected to be a basis for the next generation of multimedia digital libraries.”

This project is currently applying for EU funds under the “FP7 ICT” programme. While it did not succeed in the first call of the programme, it is currently submitted for a further round and we will provide updates as soon as an EU decision has been communicated.

175 years Public School Zurich

Wikimedia CH advised and helped in the “175 years Public School Zurich” event series, specifically in a part about Wikipedia. Christian Seidl held workshops with several classes and explained Wikipedia. Further, Wikipedia (which was deemed a ‘resource’ for the purposes of this government project) was featured in all official documentation of the Department of Education (Zurich) concerning this jubilee.

Fundraising

While the financial report of the treasurer will provide a detailed account of the association's financial success, it should just be briefly pointed out that Wikimedia CH has had a most positive year in terms of fundraising. Due to increased visibility of Wikimedia CH on Wikipedia and Wikimedia pages, we have been the second most successful chapter (in absolute revenue) and even the most successful chapter (in revenue per inhabitants).

Due to this overwhelming success, we were able to donate CHF 5000 to the Wikimedia Foundation, as support for the maintenance of the Wikimedia projects.

Official Pictures

Due to the efforts of Frédéric Schütz, we have been able to 'liberate' federal official pictures, namely portraits of historic and current Federal Councillors and Chancellors as well as all pictures from the website of the Federal Assembly. All of them can now be used on Wikimedia projects under an "Attribution only" license. We will continue working with Federal Departments and cantonal authorities in order to obtain similar licenses for further images.

Finance

We are currently professionalizing our financial structures, both in terms of accounting and in terms of billing. We are initiating electronic billing systems and are setting up a sophisticated members database which will also allow for reminders of due membership fees.

Planned projects

Informatica 08 / Celebrities write for Wikipedia

Wikimedia CH is planning a project during which Swiss celebrities are asked to and assisted in writing and submitting Open Content (texts, pictures, recordings) for Wikipedia in areas which they are knowledgeable in. The project, which was started in response to a Call for Projects of ‘informatica 08 – Swiss Year of Information Technology’, will be carried out in 2008. We are currently discussing the exact form of the project and are negotiating with possible partners.

University Library Zurich (Zentralbibliothek Zürich)

We are in contact with the University Library Zurich and are planning an event in cooperation with them in 2008. The form of the event is not yet decided but could either be a Wikipedia Day or a series of lectures / workshops in the University Library. The audience would be students, other university members and high school students on the one hand and the general public on the other hand. A detailed concept is yet to be established.
