Activities

Cooperation with Zentralbibliothek Zürich

The Zentralbibliothek Zürich (Zurich Central and University Library) has joined Wikimedia CH as supporting member and now officially adds content to the German Wikipedia under their own user account, focusing on people with a Zurich background or with connections to the Zentralbibliothek.

Moreover, together with the Zentralbibliothek, Nando Stöcklin has organised an event about Wikipedia for the public as well as a colloquium for the Zurich scientific community in autumn 2008. We would like to thank Head Librarian Oliver Thiele and the two interns Magnus Wieland and Oliver Schihin for their enthusiasm and cooperation!

Informatica08

On the occasion of the Year of Computer Science in Switzerland, Wikimedia CH aimed to launch its own project: Famous people should write articles for Wikipedia or illustrate existing articles. In order to gain access to the Swiss celebrities, we intended to cooperate with a popular TV emission, "Leben live" on SF1. The "Leben live" team was very interested in making a feature or even a small series displaying those celebrities as they write articles, make pictures or short movies for Wikipedia. Unfortunately, the plans for this project came to an untimely end when SF removed "Leben live" from its schedule in Summer 2008.

SATW workshop

Wikimedia CH has been represented by Robin Schwab at a workshop of the Swiss Academy of Engineering Sciences on November 6th and 7th. The aim of the workshop was to discuss the topic of electronic governance and to formulate recommendations for the federal administration. Wikimedia CH proposed that works which have been created or are preserved by the government should be made available in the Public Domain or under a free license, if possible this should also apply to all works where the majority of financial support comes from the government (e.g. the movie "Mais im Bundeshuus"). The first part of this system is already in use in the United States, however we aim for a more

comprehensive system which also includes cantonal administrations. We hope that this idea will now receive more publicity than before.

Free content

We have launched a coordinated effort in order to "liberate" images in Switzerland, particularly in cantonal administrations, following the good cooperation with the Federal Chancellery and the Swiss Parliament. Different cantons, both in the Romandie and in German-speaking Switzerland have been contacted and requested to provide images of politicians. This is an ongoing action but all responses so far have been positive.

Wikipedia Offline / openZIM

Wikimedia CH encourages the development of a free standard for Wikipedia offline content as well as all neccessary tools to create and read such data. We support these efforts by providing the project team around Tommi Mäkitalo and Manuel Schneider with a server and a budget for developer meetings. A first meeting has been held on 21 February 2009 and initial results have been announced for the "LinuxTag 2009" conference in June.

Wikimania 2008

With financial support from Wikimedia CH, Manuel Schneider and Patrick Kenel participated at the Wikimania, the 4th international conference of the Wikimedia movement, at the Bibliotheca Alexandrina in Alexandria (Egypt) from July 17-19. Main conference topics included communities, free knowledge, technical infrastructure and the scientific track. There was considerable participation by local Egyptians. At the conference, Manuel spoke about the Zeno File Format for 45 minutes and Patrick intervened on behalf of the above Informatica08 project in one session of short "lightning talks".

Chapters meeting

On behalf of Wikimedia CH, Ilario Valdelli and Rupert Thurner participated at the Wikimedia chapters meeting in Nijmegen, NL. The outcomes, as reported by them:

□ Cornerstones of doing fundraising in future have been discussed, and how a cooperation between chapters and Wikimedia Foundation could work out. The target would be to split donations in a country in a 50-50

ratio; if the donation was due to an involvement of the wikimedia
Foundation (WMF). the 50% part of the WMF would be paid directly to
the WMF or spent with the agreement of the WMF.
☐ General brainstorming on how the chapters could develop further. It
was agreed to report regularly so other chapters could pick up ideas
□ Discussion on how to fill the seats on the WMF's board of trustees
which the chapters are asked to nominate candidates for. The outcome
did not prove practicable afterwards, but the people knew each other
sufficiently to find a workable solution.
Wikimedia CH also financially supported Wikimedia Austria's attendance.

Chapters workspace

As many chapters requested to be able to use a 'workspace' independently from the Wikimedia Foundation's server, Wikimedia CH sponsored a mailinglist and a wiki to which all chapters board members have access. Currently, it is mainly used to discuss the nomination for the "chapters seats" on the Wikimedia Foundation's Board of Trustees, but it can be used for other discussions in the future.

Contact with like-minded organisations

Frédéric Schütz has been actively meeting other organizations in Switzerland, particularly in the Romandie, which are active in the Free Software / Open Content movement. Two reunions were held in 2008.

Domain management

Several Wikimedia-related domains in Switzerland and Liechtenstein have been registered by third parties and used to serve advertising. We have ourselves registered all the domains that were still available and have contacted the other domain holders and requested them to transfer the domains. Some domains have been transferred, with regards to others, correspondence is continuing.

E-bills

On the initiative of our treasurer, Wikimedia CH was one of the first associations in Switzerland to participate in a system of electronic bills set up by the Swiss banks and PostFinance. This will significantly decrease the administrative effort of Wikimedia CH to levy its membership fees as well as of the individual member to pay them. The





service will be more broadly publicised in 2009 after a successful pilot phase with board members.
